Important Information

Tour members will need to travel by their own transport to the first game at Bannister Park BC in time for a 12.30 pm buffet lunch and a welcome from our President. Throughout the tour, car-sharing is encouraged as parking and locating the clubs has in the past sometimes proven difficult.

Check-in at Norton Park Hotel will take place immediately following the conclusion of the opening game. Please rest assured there is plentiful parking at the hotel and staff will be on hand to assist with check-in and to transfer your luggage to your room if so required.

Dinner will be at 7.30 pm each evening. A table seating plan will be displayed outside the dining room. Dress code Sunday to Thursday evening will be smart casual with jacket and tie optional.
